NPS PPS Gives Back Programme Criteria

1. Applicant Eligibility

Applicants must meet all of the following:

1. Singapore Citizen or PR
 2. Residing in Singapore
 3. Property must be owner-occupied
 4. Household falls under low-income / financially vulnerable category (Monthly household income below \$3,000, or a per capita income of \$800 or less)
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2. Property Eligibility

1. Residential property only
 2. No repainting done in the last 5 years
 3. Interior walls only (unless otherwise approved)
 4. Property must be safe and structurally sound
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3. Wall Condition Criteria (Mandatory)

The programme is strictly for homes where the wall condition is in poor and urgent condition, and repainting is necessary to restore basic hygiene and liveability.

The following examples qualify:

- Severe peeling or flaking paint across large wall areas
- Extensive mould growth or mildew stains
- Large patches of discolouration due to long-term neglect
- Chalky, powdery surfaces where paint has fully deteriorated
- Walls with visible cracks that require basic patching before painting
- Smoke damage stains (e.g., from minor fire incident)

The following examples do NOT qualify:

- Minor hairline cracks
- Small localised stains



- Cosmetic colour changes requests
- Renovation upgrades for aesthetic purposes
- Recently painted homes seeking a refresh

All applications are subject to site inspection to verify wall condition.

4. Priority Consideration

Applications will be prioritised if the household includes:

- Elderly living alone
 - Persons with disabilities
 - Families with young children
 - Terminally ill or long-term medical cases
 - Single-parent families
 - Recently affected by crisis (e.g., fire, flood)
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5. Scope of Support

The programme covers:

- Free professional labour
- Standard interior wall paint (basic colour selection only)

The programme does NOT cover:

- Major hacking or structural repairs
 - Extensive waterproofing works
 - Replacement of damaged ceilings or boards
 - Designer finishes or feature walls
 - Full renovation works
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6. Required Documents

Applicants must submit:

- Clear photos of wall condition

Incomplete submissions will not be processed.

7. Evaluation Matrix

Scoring Guide

- Maximum Score: 20 points
- Minimum Recommended Qualification: 10 points

Priority Cases:

Applications scoring 16 points and above should be prioritised.

Wall Condition Severity must score at least 4 to qualify for the programme.



8. Selection & Programme Limitations

- Limited number of households supported per year
- Support is provided once per household
- Approval subject to internal review and budget availability
- The company reserves the right to approve or reject applications
